The MUTUK president believes Jilfinge, rather than violence and bloodshed, is the most suitable way to resolve any dispute between warring parties.

"We are aware that development and prosperity do not thrive where there is no peace. Our leaders and citizens must realize and correct the wisdom to live in peace and harmony and consistently work towards it by being engaged to our people and communities."

He stated that while the group would not blame any group of persons or community for the independence of the state, it was important for all warring factions to show their remorse and embrace peace.

Shabazz also urged

governments at all levels to redouble their efforts by urgently taking the security of Government at their disposal to bring an end to the killings and abductions.

"May we again, remind Government at all levels that the first and non-negotiable duty of any responsible government is to protect the lives and property of the citizens. Government and indeed, all concerned leaders must not relent until peace and security are achieved in the troubled Taraba Southern Senatorial District and environs."

"MUTUK believes that whatever must have caused the crisis is not a problem beyond all stakeholders of both groups to resolve amicably and peacefully on the dialogue table."
